From the 02nd to 09th of December, a seminar took place in the city of Luxembourg organized by the Luxembourgish Academy For Spectacle Sport Organization.

The program started with ice breakers, energizers and get to know each other games. We have visited the Amigo Youth House as well as ASTI NGO in Dommelange where participants were explained how these places work, and which activities they organize in order to create an impact on the environment.

VISITS

Participants have had the opportunity to visit the **Service of Streetwork** and talk with the Street Workers who were willing to share real life situations with the participants. Thorough the heated discussion the gist of the topic was tackled and experience was shared. It was interesting to follow how the same issue addresses people in multiple countries in a very specific and different way.

There was a visit to **ASTI (Service of Refugees)** where participants discussed with the people responsible for this center and the challenges they cope with on a daily basis.

Many of the participants developed a higher empathy after this visit, since they peeked in the insight of the challenges these workers face and how complex this issue is. The refugees issue is a very serious matter and should be treated with caution and in a very specific manner.



Cultural Exchange

Every night a country presentation took place where participants shared different aspects of their culture, traditional food and dances. With this not only that they have gained more knowledge on the topic, but they've also broadened their views and have learnt basic facts and interesting statistics about their peers countries.



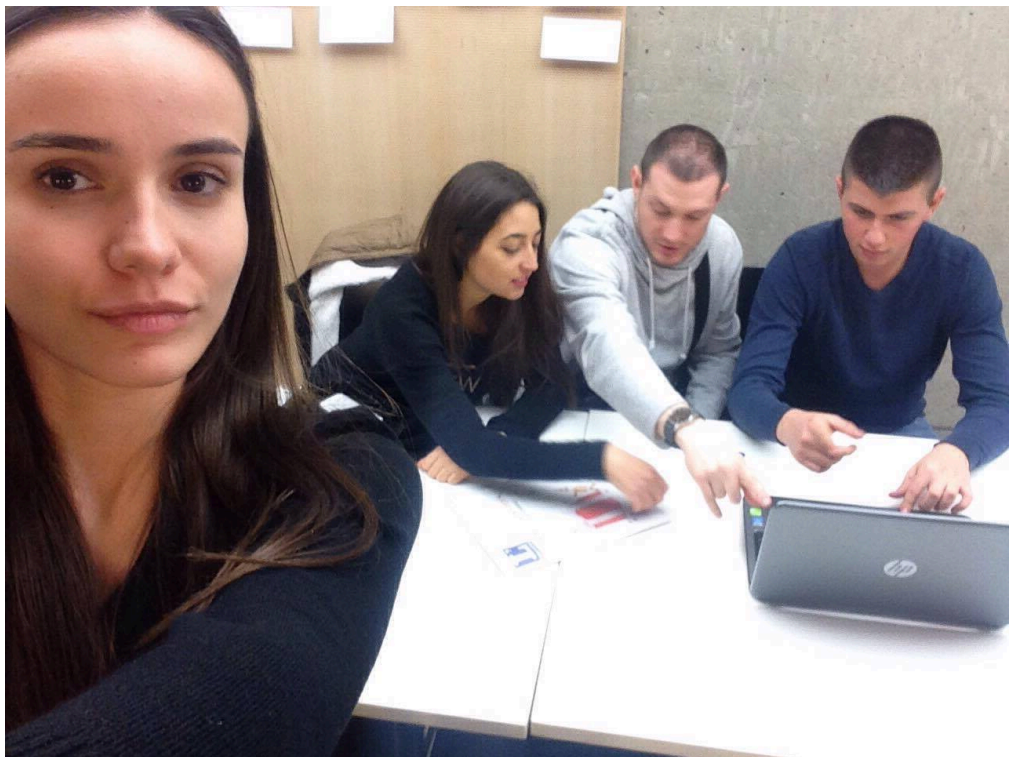
Inclusions in Youth Work
